Using the Universal Ring Measuring Guide

1. Wrap heavy string or a 4mm(1/4") wide strip of paper firmly around the base of your finger and mark the point where it overlaps.
2. Lay out the string, or paper, and measure the length to the nearest mm or 1/16".
3. Reading across the Guide, match the length with the ring system used in your country.

Hand Size

These ring size groups represent the approximate size of an adult's left hand ring finger, based on hand size.
